

Pollinator Citizen Science Data

Steps:

1. Fill in: Location, Date, Time Start, Number of People in Group
2. Write down (or draw) all the pollinators you see and hear.
 - a. Do your best not to count the same pollinator twice.
 - b. If you do not know what species a pollinator is, write down as much information as possible and draw or take a picture. You can use guide books, and tablets apps, SEEK and iNaturalist, to help you identify.
3. Fill in: Time End, Duration, Distance Covered
