The hunting ban was lifted by Todd Loewen officially on July 9th, and announced on June 29th.

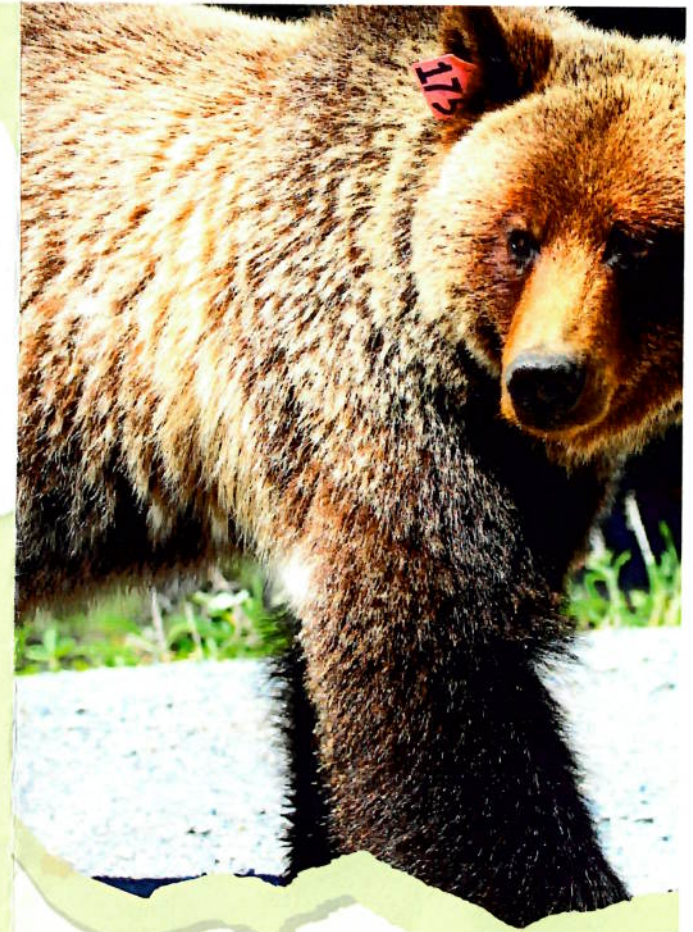
