Land Acknowledgement: With gratitude, I acknowledge that we live and work on lands that, until recently, were occupied exclusively by people of the Siksika Nation, the Piikani Nation, the Kainai Nation, the Îethka Stoney Nakoda Nation (consisting of the Chiniki, Bears paw and Goodstoney Nations), the people of the Tsuut'ina Nation, and the Otipemisiwak Métis Nation of Alberta. Today, southern Alberta is home to Indigenous people from all over North America. At CPAWS Southern Alberta, we are committed to challenging colonial practices, especially those related to education and land protection. We are committed to addressing the legacy of broken promises of Treaty 7. We are committed to the Truth and Reconciliation Commission's Calls to Action and to adopting and applying the principles of the United Nations Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples.
